Medications

Data Abstraction Instructions:

Record for each medication if it was administered Pre, During, and Post, if it was Contraindicated, and also if it was Not Given. Record for each medication if it was prescribed Home (at admission), Discharge.

Selections:

- Medications at Admission (Home Meds) = Prescribed medications the patient was taking prior to the current episode of care.
- Pre = Medications administered from admission, or previous procedure, to the start of the current procedure.
- Within 24 hours=administered within 24 hours of PCI procedure start and/or during PCI procedure.
- During =Medications administered during the time the patient was in the procedure area for the current procedure. (while patient is physically in the PCI lab, PVI lab, or operating room).
- Post = Medications administered from the time the patient has left the procedure area through discharge, or next procedure, whichever is first.
- Discharge = Prescribed medications on which the patient was discharged.
 - Pt. deceased or discharge location(NCDR V5 #10110) "other acute care hospital", AMA, or (NCDR V5 #10115) Hospice Care
- Contraindicated = History of allergy/reaction/sensitivity/intolerance to medication that is documented in the patient record or a
 physician dictation which states a contraindication.
- Not Given = If the drug was not administered to the patient at any time.

Supporting Definitions:

Vascular surgery discharge medications should not be entered on a patient that dies prior to discharge.

For Combination Therapy record as follows:

In case of combination drugs individual components should be recorded unless the specific option is available to select. e.g., zestoretic is a combination of lisinopril and hydrochlorothiazide (HCTZ); this should be recorded as ACE inhibitor and diuretic. e.g. entresto is a combination of sacubitril and valsartan, since entresto is a specific selection, this should be recorded as entresto.
